

HURGHADA HIGHLIGHTS



HURGHADA CITY: Once an isolated and modest fishing village, Hurghada has metamorphosed into a sprawling collection of more than 100 hotels, and is now Egypt's most popular resort destination. Hurghada is an Egyptian town with a diversity missing from the airbrushed resort atmosphere of Sharm el-Sheikh. Set on the Red Sea coast, Hurghada is holiday central for diving, snorkeling, sailing and fishing trips. A good base for excursions to Luxor or Cairo, Hurghada turns into a party town by night, with hotel restaurants and nightclubs turning up the heat. With warm temperatures year-round and little chance of rain, it's also a popular winter holiday destination.

Take a ride on a **Beach Buggy** into the desert and experience life as lived by the Bedouin people. You will dine under the stars in a traditional style tent, eating a delicious barbecue cooked over a hot fire. This is a fascinating experience and one not to be missed, enjoying the desert under the night sky.



DIVING: The Red Sea has some of the best diving in the world. It is part of the Great Rift Valley: a trough running from Palestine to some degrees south of the equator. This immense crack in the Earth's surface makes for an extremely deep sea, reaching nearly 3000 m. It also explains small islands like the Brothers dive site. Steep-sided and far from land, they were probably thrown up by volcanic actions as the rift opened.
