## FRIST TIME

### COMPANY'S BRANCHES IN EGYPT

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**Mobile phones:** You can choose to roam with your international number by registering on any of the three mobile phone operator networks in Egypt. Alternatively, you may want to purchase a temporary visitor line from one of the providers. **Land-lines:** In addition to their availability in all hotels, payphones are also available in some cities.

**Internet:** Wireless internet is available in a large number of restaurants, hotels and coffee shops throughout the country. Some may provide the service for free while others may charge you for it. Hotels offer wired and wireless access in the comfort of your own room. Some cities, like Sharm El Sheikh, are fully connected using wireless internet connectivity.

## FAST FACTS

**Weather and climate:** There's never a bad time to visit Egypt. It's always t-shirt weather in this part of the world. During the country's hot, dry summers, it's not unusual for temperatures to climb to as high as 38 (°C), with very little chance of rain. Spring and autumn are the most comfortable times to visit if you'd prefer less sticky highs in the mid-20s. The weather remains warm in winter. Temperatures rarely dropping below 20 even at the peak of the season.

## GETTING AROUND

**By minibus:** Each resort has a good network of minibuses operating around the main towns. These usually operate on a fixed route and you can call out to the driver when you want to get off. / **By taxi:** It's easy to flag down a taxi, but if they don't use the meter, then ensure you agree a price in advance and pay only at the end of the journey. / **By shuttle bus:** Many hotels operate shuttle buses into town or the nearest beach.

## EVENTS

**New Year:** The year starts with a bang with Pacha Sharm El-Sheikh's elaborate New Year's Eve party. / **Camel racing:** The South Sinai Camel Festival sees tribes from throughout Egypt gather at Sharm El-Sheikh, for entertaining camel races. / **Ramadan:** Throughout Egypt the fasting month of Ramadan is marked, although it won't be as disruptive in the resorts as elsewhere in the country. Immediately afterwards, the festivals of Eid al-Fitr, and later Eid al-Adha, are holidays when Egyptian families will often travel to resorts, so these are likely to be busier.

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
